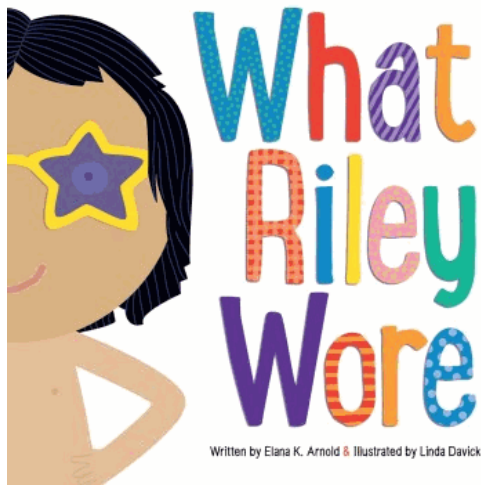

8	On Wednesday, Riley wore a ball gown out to dinner with Otto and Oma because they went to a fancy restaurant, and ball gowns are the fanciest. The illustration on this page depicts Riley, whom is not identified as a boy nor girl throughout the book, wearing a dress, bracelets and headband.
10	The illustration depicts Riley, wearing a fancy dress and bracelets. The grandmother is hugging Riley and attempting to wipe a red spot on Riley's dress.
13	It rained on Friday, so Riley wore a colorful combination of rubber boots, a police officer jacket, and the world's best tutu. <i>See Figure 3.</i>
14	The illustration depicts Riley wearing a combination of "boy clothes" and "girl clothes". Riley is wearing a camouflaged helmet, police jacket and pink tutu. <i>See</i>
21	The illustrations depict a "boy" sock on one foot and a "girl" sock on another foot.
23	This illustration depicts Riley from behind naked except for a "boy" sock on one foot, a "girl" sock on another foot; a dinosaur hat on their head; holding a pink tutu in one hand a red monster shirt in the other hand Riley stars happily at the closet depicted on page 24.
24	The illustration on this page is a depiction of Riley's closet with contains various "boys" and "girl" clothes, shoes and hats.
