

9	There is inequality in the criminal justice system. However, this inequality has roots outside the system.
12	The civil rights movement led to major changes in racial equality. However, systemic racism and police brutality continue today.
15	A person's skin color should not affect how he or she is treated by the criminal justice system. But many laws and policies affect people of color more than white people. People of color are often at a disadvantage. This is called systemic racism.
19	The criminal justice system negatively affects people of color from an early age.
20	Black students receive harsher punishments than white students for breaking similar rules.
30	The Black Lives Matter movement began in 2013. Its organizers want to stop violence against Black communities. They want to affirm the importance of all Black people's lives.

33	One movement is to defund the police. Defunding the police means taking some money away from police departments.
