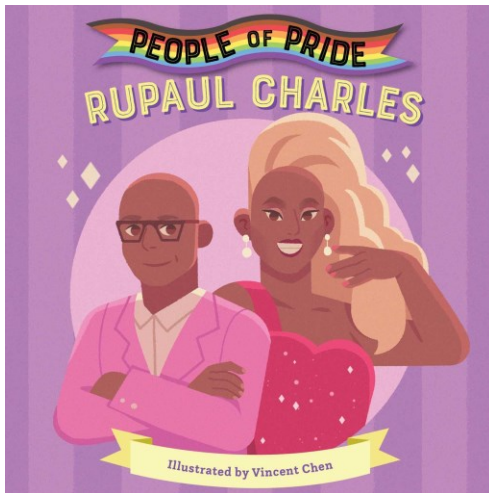


PEOPLE OF PRIDE: RUPAUL CHARLES

2	RuPaul is a singer, a model, an actor, a talk show host, a drag queen, and a trailblazer.
5	Soon, RuPaul was performing in drag. Drag is when a person dresses as a gender that is different than their own.
6	As RuPaul would say, "You're born naked and the rest is drag."
10	RuPaul is openly gay. A gay person loves someone who is the same gender as themselves.
11	At that time, LGBTQ people did not have equal rights. They could not get married , and service members could be discharged from the military if they were openly gay. For many, it was hard to stay positive.
12	But drag queens have a long history of changing society. From actors to activists, Shakespeare to Stonewall, drag has played an important part in making the world a more accepting place. The illustration on this page depicts three individuals standing next to each other. The individual in the middle of the group has a pride flag and is angrily shouting. <i>See Figure 1.</i>

15	Soon, RuPaul had a talk show on TV. Some viewers learned about drag queens and LGBTQ culture. But for many, it was the first time they felt seen.
